Individuals, broken by age, ability, and male and female, will be assigned a team and a coach to work on team playing concepts.

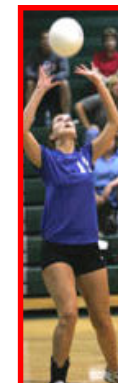
5:00 - 6:00 INSTRUCTIONAL GAMES

Matt Twomey – Methuen HS Varsity Boys and Girls Coach



In 2005 Matt was chosen to reform the Methuen girls program as their new varsity coach. After 4 seasons at the helm, the Rangers have been crowned MVC Champions in 2006, 2007 and 2008 in addition to becoming regulars in the Division I Playoffs. In the spring of 2009 Matt

was named the new head coach of the Methuen boy's program, taking over for EJ. His knowledge of the game is unsurpassed in this region, as he has been a Junior Olympic coach for the past 8 years, bringing teams to the NERVA Regional finals. Coach Twomey's playing resume is also exemplary as he was a star outside hitter on a Methuen team was crowned Merrimack Valley Champs and State Semi-finalists.

Dan Young – Salem High Varsity Girls Coach



Dan Young was hired by Salem in 2005 to revive the great tradition of Salem Volleyball. In his first year the Blue Devils went 16-3, falling in the state semi-finals. In 2006 success only continued as Salem went undefeated and won its first state title in more than 10 years (1996). In 2007 Salem retained their

title and were once again crowned New Hampshire Division I State Champions. Coach Young's 6-year record at Salem is an impressive 112-16. An experienced coach who began at the JV ranks at Central Catholic in 1999 now coaches is the co-director of Lat-42 Volleyball Club. Coach Young is also an assistant for the Central Catholic
