EJ Perry – Salem High Varsity Boys Coach



Volleyball became an official sport in NH in 2004. Coach Perry and his Salem team have *still* not lost a match. An enthusiastic coach who always gets the most out of his players EJ guided his team to undefeated 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 AND 2009 campaigns. The 2005 season saw Coach Perry's team defeat EVERY team by a score of 3-0. Coach Perry has made Salem the dominant force in NH volleyball. In 2004 EJ took over the Methuen, MA boys program. In one season, a team that hadn't been in post-season play in 4 years was back in. In 2005 they reached the North finals and in 2006 and 2007 they reached the North Semi-finals. He stepped down as the Methuen coach in 2009 to spend more time with his 3 children. EJ also coaches the boy's basketball team in Salem, NH - another perennial power house under his guidance.

Matt Twomey – Methuen HS Varsity Boys and Girls Coach



In 2005 Matt was chosen to reform the Methuen girls program as their new varsity coach. After 5 seasons at the helm, the Rangers have been crowned MVC Champions in 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 in addition to becoming regulars in the Division I Playoffs. In the spring of 2009 Matt was named the new head coach of the Methuen boy's program, taking over for EJ. His knowledge of the game is unsurpassed in this region, as he has been a Junior Olympic coach for the past 8 years, bringing teams to the NERVA Regional finals. Coach Twomey's playing resume is also exemplary as he was a star outside hitter on a Methuen team was crowned Merrimack Valley Champs and State Semi-finalists.

Dan Young – Salem High Varsity Girls Coach



Dan Young was hired by Salem in 2005 to revive the great tradition of Salem Volleyball. In his first year the Blue Devils went 16-3, falling in the state semi-finals. In 2006 success only continued as Salem went undefeated and won its first state title in more than 10 years (1996). In 2007 Salem retained their title and were once again crowned New Hampshire Division I State Champions. Coach Young's 5-year record at Salem is an impressive 92-11. An experienced coach who began at the JV ranks at Central Catholic in 1999 now coaches at the club level with Latitude 42. Coach Young is also an assistant for the Central Catholic boy's team.
